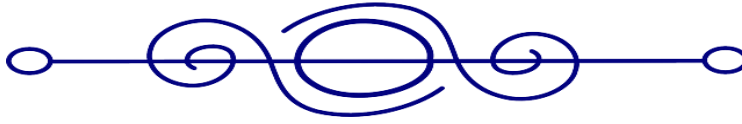

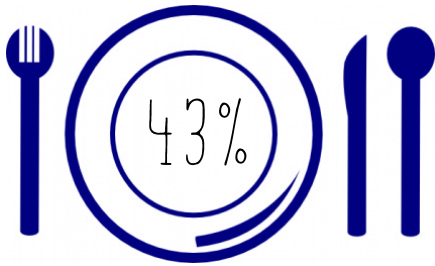

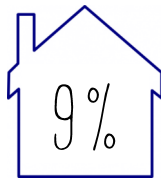

43%
of our budget is dedicated to basic needs assistance, including help with food, utilities, rent, clothing, and prescriptions, as well as financial literacy education and budgeting. The First Step Program provides material assistance (formula, diapers, wipes and other baby essentials) and case management services to low-income pregnant women and families with children ages 0-3.



20%
of our budget is dedicated to services for older adults, such as Senior Support (Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull Counties), Guardianship (Ashtabula County), Adult Day Services (Stark County), and the Senior Center/Home-Delivered Meals Program (East Liverpool).



9%
of our budget is dedicated to homeless outreach and case management services, homeless prevention, housing counseling, permanent housing, and other services to keep individuals and families in their homes.



18%
of our budget is dedicated to social, educational, and other local supportive services, including:

- ◆ Bereavement Services & Family Support (Columbiana, Mahoning & Trumbull Counties)
- ◆ Caritas Café (Ravenna)
- ◆ Christina House Domestic Violence Shelter & Services (Columbiana County)
- ◆ Cooking Matters at the Store (Ashtabula and Stark Counties)
- ◆ Criminal Justice Linkage/Re-entry Services (Ashtabula, Mahoning, Portage & Trumbull Counties)
- ◆ Opening Doors Parenting Program (Ashtabula)
- ◆ Representative Payeeship (Ashtabula County)
- ◆ School-based Abstinence Education (Ashtabula County)



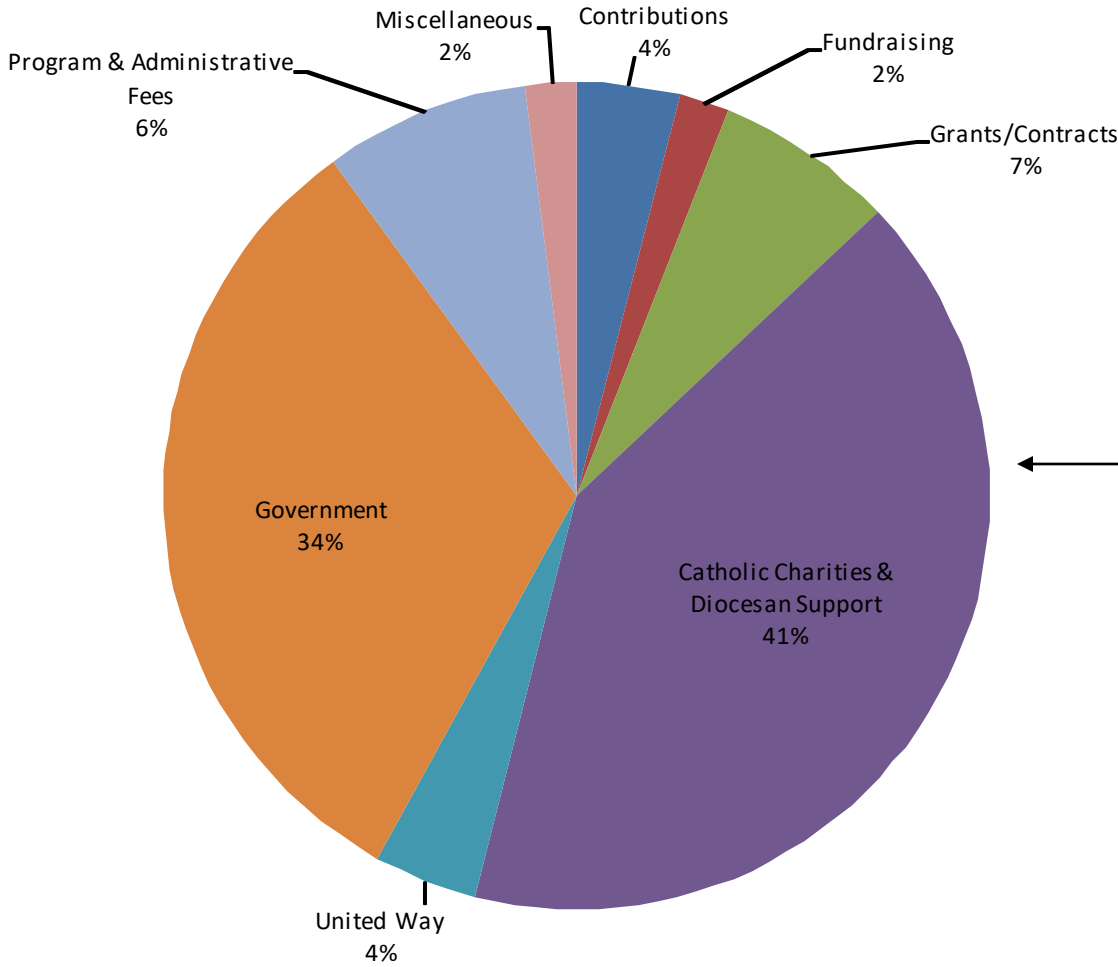
10%
