- Have you paid at least \$75 towards your own bill in the past 90 days?

Documents needed include (but aren't limited to):

- Most recent AEP electric bill
- Driver's License or State ID for all adults in the home
- One (1) month of pay stubs for each person working in the home
- All income must be verified (present copies of child support, Social Security, pensions, etc.)
